It is excellent for winter grain crop rotations and freezes off reliably. Therefore, it can also be established before the cultivation of sugarbeets or oilseed rape. Furthermore, TerraLife® N-Fixx leaves very good soil tilth, creates humus and contributes to the health and vitalisation of heavily used soils. The subsequently released nitrogen must be considered during N-fertilisation of the follow-on crop.
