Fast development and nematode resistant

Profile

PASSION is resistant to nematodes (resistance to *Heterodera schachtii* Cat. 2); it has a low tendency to lodging and grows quickly in its early development. PASSION produces an intermediate dry matter yield and is therefore excellent for mulch cropping.

- Suitable for late sowing

- Fast plant development
