Profile

GORILLA is a dark purple green, re-growing forage rape. The stature of GORILLA is slightly shorter than many current varieties but with good standing ability. The dry matter content of GORILLA is higher than average which leads to high total dry matter yields. GORILLA shows a moderately good resistance to powdery mildew and is quite resistant to club root. With its good regrowth potential, it can be used for both, silage-mixtures and grazing.
