Fodder radish

(*Raphanus sativus*)



Three times excellent against nematodes



RADETZKY combines four nematode resistances in one variety: resistance against *Heterodera schachtii*, and resistance against *Meloidogyne chitwoodi*, *Meloidogyne fallax* and *Meloidogyne minor*. The excellent nematode resistance of this variety is combined with a low flowering tendency and a very low to low tendency for lodging. It is the ideal cover crop for beet, potato and vegetable cultivation.
