DAKOTA maintains excellent forage quality and has a strong balanced multiple pest resistance package to give a long stand life. It shows especially high resistance against Phytophthora root rot, even under flooding conditions.

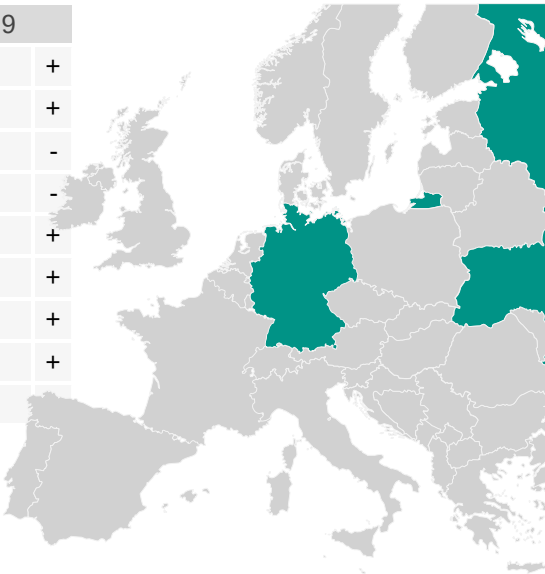
